

Carriage for Forklift

Forklift Carriage - There are 4 sizes of hook type fork carriages rated by the tine carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type fork carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
